

Critical Plan of Action (POA):

Adherence and completion before next PEER Team visit

Basis the infrastructure audit reports submitted by respective teams there are critical areas that need immediate confrontation.

It is recommended that the current format of reporting should be restructured into a more comprehensible format with elementary categories like:

- 1) Hygiene
- 2) Safety
- 3) Sanitation
- 4) Infrastructure
- A prominent area of concern is lack of proper sanitation and safety system in the college. Having a committee to undertake the above mentioned project should help to share the responsibility. The committee should take up the task of providing proper toilets for girls/boys & staff along with making drinking water easily available.
- The objective of the infrastructure audit is to identify the need gap analysis for no. of classrooms, reading rooms, labs, hostel facilities etc. and not merely a count of the no. of chairs and electrical fixtures in the college. Dedicate space for a reading room for the students. To that effect, the current auditorium space should be restored into a reading room for the students. Ensure there is proper lighting, ventilation and drinking water facility in the room
- It is understood right now that the college is short on laboratory space. Matters like these need urgent attention. Need identification for additional lab space should be done within the next 10 working days time.
- Similarly, the current girl's hostel building holds no security infrastructure and is openly accessible to unsocial elements. Inversing the location of the girl's hostel with the current location of the boy's hostel should be done at the soonest and putting up a strict security system in place should also be given utmost importance
- Lastly, any plan is merely a plan unless a timeline is affixed to it. It is critical that the
 management puts down a timeline to execute each of these points and make the college
 NAAC accreditation ready.
