

Skilled Development - Employment Cell

Devgad College operates an Employment Cell that works towards sharing job/internship opportunities with students who wish to pursue work options while studying (under the 'earn and learn' program) or after graduation. However, the number of students who benefit from this arrangement are only a handful, while majority of others step into the job market with no work experience or trained skills at all. This makes their employment seeking process tougher and more often than not students land up with entry level opportunities that offer limited growth prospects.

To deal with this situation, the EC proposes to introduce a 'Skill Development Program' for students that can equip them with technical / creative skills appropriate across industries and economic sectors. Under this program students can acquire training via the internship model or by enrolling for skill development courses that can be started under the aegis of Devgad College.

With common consensus, skills that the students can be trained for can be shortlisted and an execution model can be designed for the same.

The Employment Cell of Devgad College shall contact all Government and Semi Government Offices including the local planning and law enforcement authorities, local industrial units, fishing and agriculture sector, co operative societies etc and request them to provide weekly work opportunities at their work place. The students will get work culture exposure and it will boost their confidence.

This program should help us to create a convergence for our students across sectors and also give the job market trained skilful talent.
