Upon completion of this procedure, the student/s will be further screened through a round of interview, set with the objective to understand the thought process behind the student/s aspiration and reasoning abilities. Successful student/s will be supported through a SEED funding scheme that will enable them to seek project funding up a limit of Rs. 50,000/-.
