### Day 1 (23/12/2017)

#### Inauguration

As already decided, the inauguration of the NSS residential camp was done by
plating two saplings of coconut tree at the Primary School campus,
Mithmumbari in the hands of Mr. Balkrishna Gaokar, Sarpanch, Mithmumbari
Grampanchayat and Dr. G. T. Parulekar, Principal. The saplings were donated
by one of the participant NSS volunteer in the Ms. Damini Katwankar.

On this occasion Mr. Balkrishna Gaokar, Dr. G. T. Parulekar, Mr. S. V. Kurlikar, Vice-Principal; Dr. Mrs S.M. Jambale, Vice-Principal; Mrs. Walawalkar, Supervisor expressed their thoughts and extended their well wished for success of camp.

Dr. Kamat, Prof. Daptardar, Prof. Teurwadkar, Prof. Jayant Naik, Prof. Shewale, Head Master of Primary school, Raju Mumbarkar were present during the function.

• Instructions of discipline were given. General daily schedule was informed. Groups of volunteers from were set and daily responsibilities were assigned.

# Day 2 (24/12/2017)

The day began with Yoga and pranayam. Mukta Paranjape, a volunteer representative demonstrated Yoga exercises to the volunteers. As per the schedule the primary school campus was cleaned.

#### Workshop

Theme:पर्यटन विकासामध्ये महिलांचा सहभागExpert:Ms. Kanchantai Parulekar, Swayamsiddha, Kolhapur.

The session comprised of speech and demonstration. Following points were discussed:

- purpose of self-help groups
- meaning of sustainable tourism development and its necessity
- importance of considering minor details such as shape, smell, packing of products
- ways of involvement of women in tourism and small scale business etc.

Simultaneously, one of Kanchantai's colleagues, Priyatai, was demonstrating recipes and procedures of preparing decoration items.

Recipes of chikki, popcorn, rajgira ladu were shown. The articles such as fabric bags, footwear, mobile pouches etc., wooden and bamboo articles etc were made known. Also, preparation of wax candles of variety of shapes, show items from wax were demonstrated.

The prepared items were distributed among the participants.

Around 70 women from 17 *Mahila Bachat Gat* were keenly participated. It was very useful workshop very received by local community.

A couple of women spontaneously came forward to share their feedbacks on completion of the workshop.

# Day 3 (25/12/2017)

Yoga and NSS prayers were sung before proceeding to *shramdaan*. Mr. Sainath Gaokar, a reporter from Konkan News channel covered news of the NSS camp. It was an opportunity for the volunteers to appear before camera.

Socio-economic survey of the village was started. The volunteers in various groups with their respective group leaders approached the families in Boudhwadi, Adwadi, Madhaliwadi, Khalchi wadi and Bagwadi. This activity induced confidence of interacting with the community among the volunteers.

# Lecture

Theme: मिठम्ंबरी व शाश्वत पर्यटन

Expert: Dr. Prasad Deodhar, Bhagirath Pratishtan, Kudal

He discussed very minute details regarding:

- Choice of proper place for tourism development.
- Grooming of local community in all dimensions for tourism development.
- Development of observation skills to identify gaps to start a business.
- Prime importance of English language, well mannered guides, responsibility of local community to maintain decency towards the tourists, clean toilets etc.
- Emphasis on monitoring the quality and quantity of tourism so as to preserve the culture of village.
- Repayment of loans for further development.

# Day 4 (26/12/2017)

The day began as usual. But the difference was all the boys and girls went on a jog together with the programme officers. Then Yoga exercises were done in the ground of Marathi Primary School. NSS songs were sung in chorus.

Beach cleaning was set to complete. It was resolved and suggested by the Sarpanch in gramsabha, Mithmumbari that NSS volunteers should participate and help the self help groups in preparation of Beach Festival. The volunteers cleaned the garbage and plastic and glass material were collected separately.

#### Lecture 1

Synopsis of the Lecture:

- Session was quite interactive and expert discussed questions asked by participants.
- The efforts and ideas used to set up the resort. Stages and steps involved in resort business.

- Qualities and vision an entrepreneur needs to posses.
- Sharing of memorable experiences and incidences during the journey of resort business.
- How mouth publicity helps the tourists to reach a good holiday destination without any advertisement of resort.
- Success story and the ways to provide meaningful holiday destinations with concepts.

# Lecture 2

Theme: World torusim

- As a world tourist, Mr. Godse shared glimpses of his visits to various countries viz. China, USA etc.
- He mentioned that visiting various countries and cultures is a self-grooming exercise.
- Also, he mentioned various occupations and required expertise for tourism development

# Day 5 (27/12/2017)

Exercise, NSS prayer and other patriotic songs were sung in the morning. Task of cleaning the beach of Bagwadi and Mumbradevi temple area was done.

# Lecture 1

Theme: Experience sharing: A successful businessman

Expert: Mr. Sanjay Kolambkar, owner of Hotel Vsant Vijay

- An organized narration of success story in the hotel business.
- The hardships faced to raise to the place he stands today.
- He mentioned a few human qualities which would help students to be successful such as never giving up, being good at heart, not to be ashamed of any kind of work etc.
- He answered questions asked by students such as why he has chosen hotel business, had it happened ever he thought of quitting the business, what keeps him going etc.

# Lecture 2

# Observations

- 8. Conducting awareness programs for villagers to pay back the loans.
